ADRIAN – LaVonne Hamilton, 95, of Adrian died Saturday afternoon, February 13, 2021 at Brookdale Adrian where she had been residing for the past couple of years.

Born October 17, 1925 in North East (Erie County), Pennsylvania, she was the daughter of Esther (Haskell) and Albert Haslett. LaVonne earned her Bachelor's and her Master's degrees in Social Work from the University of Michigan. After a brief career as a Supervisor of Field Work at the Universities of Wayne State and Michigan, she married Dr. John D. Hamilton in 1950, who preceded her in death in 1989.

LaVonne was a member of the Tau Delta and Alpha Omega Sororities, as well as the American Academy of Social Workers. She was also an active member of the Adrian First United Methodist Church.

She is survived by her daughters, Suzanne Kindel of California, and Sheila Hamilton of New Mexico; nephew, William Moore; and many close friends.

LaVonne was preceded in death by her parents; her husband of 39 years, Dr. John D. Hamilton; and her daughter, Sarah Hamilton in 2008.
