JASPER — Lewis “Lewie” E. Keller, age 69, of Jasper died Friday evening, June 26, 2020 at Promedica Toledo Hospital. Born March 26, 1951, he was the son of the late Earl and Leila (Cole) Keller.

Lewie was a 1969 graduate of Sand Creek High School. He proudly served in the United States Army following the Vietnam War, where he was stationed in Germany. Lewie attended college and earned his license as a Barber. He worked as a barber in Jasper for over 10 years. Lewie was the Owner and Operator of Jasper Camper Sales for over 40 years. He was also employed by the Fairfield Township Water Department.

On August 8, 1975, Lewie married Sandra Bauschka in Adrian. Sandy survives to cherish the memories they created over the past 44 years they shared together.

Lewie was an active member and Elder of Saint Stephen’s Lutheran Church in Adrian. In his spare time, he enjoyed his rose and vegetable gardens, cooking and baking. Lewie especially enjoyed teaching his granddaughter, Korinne, to cook and bake. He treasured his time with his grandson, Chase, working on Chase’s tractor. Lewie was an organ donor.

Surviving in addition to his wife, Sandra, is his daughter, Jennifer (Aeron) Baker of Saline and son, Brad Schoonover; two grandchildren, Korinne and Chase Baker; and a sister, Mary Yocum of Charlotte, NC; and a niece and nephew. He will be missed by many friends and neighbors.

In addition to his parents, Lewie was preceded in death by three sisters.

Memorial services will be held at 1 p.m., Sunday, July 19, 2020 at St. Stephen’s Lutheran Church, Adrian, with pastor Brian Keller officiating. Due to the COVID 19 Pandemic, there will be limited capacity and it is requested that you should wear a mask. Services will be recorded and available after the date.
