ADRIAN – Alberto G. Rodriguez, 77, of Adrian, went to be with his Lord and Savior Wednesday, January 12, 2011, at his home where he was under the loving care of his family.

Alberto was born August 23, 1933 in San Benito, Texas, the son of Narsiszo and Esperanza Gonzalez. During the Korean Conflict, he served his country in the Army.

On August 15, 1953, Alberto married Eugenia “Jeannie” Perez in Monroe, Michigan. Eugenia, his devoted wife of over 57 years, survives.

Albert was an engineer at Tecumseh Products, retiring in 1991 with 40 years of service. He also worked for Lenawee Hills Memorial Park for several years. Albert was a man of many talents. He was an amateur photographer and also shared his musical ability as a member of several different bands.

A faithful member, pastor, and prophet of Christ Temple Ministries, Albert worked extensively with missionaries and migrant workers.

Most precious to Albert is his family. In addition to his wife, he is survived by their children: José Louis (Sharon) Rodriguez; Ricardo Rodriguez, both of Adrian; David (Kim) Rodriguez of Leesburg, Florida; and Catherine Rodriguez
