BLISSFIELD – Alice V. Petee, age 94 of Blissfield, passed away Tuesday, May 6, 2014, at the Hospice of Lenawee Home.

She was born July 12, 1919, in Adrian, Michigan to George and Pearl (Beaman) Schulz. Alice graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1937, and attended Adrian College.

On September 21, 1940, Alice was married to Lawrence “Putt” Petee, and he preceded her in death in 2008 having celebrated 68 years of marriage.

Alice shared her love of music by teaching piano and organ to generations of students. She was a member of the Blissfield First Presbyterian Church where she was the organist for many years. Alice was a member of the Blissfield Historical Society and one of the founding members of the Blissfield Garden Club. She also played piano for the Blissfield Rotary Club meetings.

She is survived by her children: Janet (Robert) Beutler of Sand Creek; Patricia (Eugene) Knoblauch of Ottawa Lake; and Edward Petee of Blissfield; grandchildren: Paula Knoblauch, Eli (Julie) Beutler and Abi Beutler; and great grandchildren Adam and Mary Grace Beutler.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by sisters, Grace Lorraine and Kathryn Bowen; and a brother, George Schulz.
