Alice A. Walberg, 96, of Tipton, was gently ushered into the rest promised her because of her personal faith in her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, Saturday, June 16, 2012.

She was born October 4, 1915, in Linden, Iowa, the daughter of Samuel and Bessie (Davis) Wilcox. On July 1, 1950, Alice married John A. Walberg in Oak Park, Illinois. They celebrated over 35 years of marriage prior to his death in 1986.

Alice's love of the Lord was evident in her kind, gracious spirit, and in her giving service to others. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in Lansing, Illinois, and attended West Rome Baptist Church after moving to Tipton in 1999.

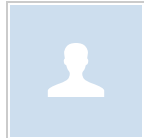

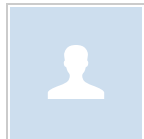
