YPSILANTI—Andrew Stewart Damon-Heath “ADH”, age 24 of Adrian, passed away unexpectedly Friday, August 22, 2014.

He was born October 28, 1989, in Adrian, Michigan to Mary Katherine Heath and Mark Alan Nosal.

Andrew graduated in 2008 from Adrian High School where he was a member of Upward Bound, the marching band, the tennis, bowling and soccer teams, and was in several school musicals. During high school Andrew worked at Wagley Funeral Home where he became a part of the Wagley Family. He earned a Bachelor’s Degree in Criminal Justice Administration from Eastern Michigan University. During his college years, Andrew was a member of Phi Sigma Kappa, serving as president; and kept active in a mixed martial arts club and playing club soccer and softball.

Andrew proudly served in the United States Navy and the Reserves.

In addition to his mother, Mary Katherine (Bill Brown) Simmons of Adrian and his father, Mark Nosal of Alaska, he is survived by his siblings: Jacob and Rebekah Simmons and Benjamin Brown, all of Adrian; Michael Brown of Cleveland, TN; and Todd, Robyn and Gail Nosal all of Alaska; maternal grandparents, Mary Anne Heath and Larry Heath Sr., both of Adrian; paternal grandparents, Joseph and Jackie Weinberg of Jackson, MI; aunt, Amanda (Jeff) Scroggins and uncle, Larry (Angie) Heath Jr., both of Adrian; and numerous extended family members.

He was preceded in death by an uncle, Todd Nosal.

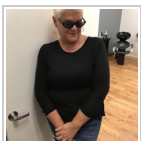
