



Andrew Engardio

April 27, 1923 - June 27, 2023

Orlando, FL- Andrew Engardio, 100, of Orlando, Florida died June 27, 2023 at his home at Westminster Towers, where he was a resident since 2018. He was born and grew up in Williamston, Michigan. Saying that Andrew enjoyed music and dance was an understatement. Even at 100, he would break into song or look for a willing dance partner at a party. Andrew was a World War II veteran having served as Quartermaster for Europe. Andrew and his 5 other brothers served in the military at the same time during World War II which is now no longer possible. After the war, Andrew used the GI Bill to attend Dr. Scholl Podiatry School in Chicago, IL and began his practice in Adrian, MI. There he met his wife Annajean Hermes and they married in 1952. Andrew was the Choir Director at St. Joseph's Catholic Church for many years. Andrew retired in 1978 and he and Annajean moved to Brevard, NC. Later they lived in Spring Hill, FL and Port St Lucie, FL. After Annajean's death in 2007, Andrew

moved back to Adrian where he enjoyed line dancing with friends at the Senior Center until moving to Orlando in 2018. Survivors include daughters Catherine Engardio Winters and her husband Raymond S. Winters of Port Salerno, FL, Nancy J. Engardio and her husband Randall H. Parker of Kalamazoo, MI; a son, Samuel J. Engardio and his wife Kathy Engardio of Winter Garden, FL, seven grandchildren and six great grandchildren. Andrew will be laid to rest next to his wife at St Joseph's Catholic Cemetery in Adrian, MI.
