ANN ARBOR – Andrew E. Fisher, II, age 67 of Brooklyn, passed away Monday, November 10, 2014, at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor.

He was born November 27, 1946 in Adrian, Michigan to Edward and Delia (Baisch) Fisher.

Andrew graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1964. During his school years he played Legion baseball. He earned a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Michigan where he continued to play baseball and was recognized as the Big 10 Batting Champion during his sophomore year.

In 1969 Andrew married Donna "Missy" Hays in Grosse Pointe, Michigan, and they were blessed with 45 years together.

Andrew worked for Johnson Controls Automotive Group, retiring with 30 years of service. He enjoyed playing golf and was a great fan of University of Michigan sports.
