PORT HURON – Anne Marie Slusher, age 80, formerly of Adrian, died Thursday afternoon, February 11, 2021 at McLaren Port Huron Hospital in St. Clair County.

Born on January 25, 1941, in Bristol, VA, she was the daughter of Waldo and Lelia (Heselschweredt) Ehnis. She was a graduate of Clinton High School. Anne earned her Bachelor's Degree in Pharmacy Science from the University of Michigan in 1962. She was a proud member of the American Association of University Women (AAUW).

Anne was employed throughout the Adrian area as a Pharmacist - Lenawee Medical Care Facility, Bixby Medical Center, Rexall Pharmacy, and working in the Maria Hall at Siena Heights University. Anne was an active member of the Adrian First United Methodist Church, where she volunteered her time at dinners and large events. She also loved working with younger children and taught in the Church Nursery.

In her spare time, Anne volunteered at the Croswell Opera House and enjoyed gardening and baking. In her younger years she spent time with her children as a Scout Leader – Girl Scouts and Cub Scouts.

Anne is survived by her two children, Bill (Catherine Kosmala) Slusher of Fort

Gratiot, MI and Catherine Slusher of Milwaukee, WI; grandson, Vaughn Anthony Slusher of Fort Gratiot; three brothers, Richard Ehnis of Adrian, Robert (Wendy) Ehnis of Lansing, and William (Shirley) Ehnis of Adrian; three nephews, Jonathan (Raquel) Ehnis, Ben (Sarah) Ehnis, and Tanner (Katie) Ehnis; and three grand-nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Waldo and Leila Ehnis.

Visitation for Anne will take place on Friday, February 19, 2021 at Wagley Funeral Home, Adrian from 12:00 noon to 1:00 p.m. Following the Governor's executive order, all attendees are required to wear a proper face covering, with the exception of those under the age of five years old or those who cannot medically tolerate.
