Deerfield: Ardis A. Witt, 93 of Deerfield passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 12, 2010 at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ypsilanti, MI. She was born on May 9, 1917 in Adrian, Michigan, the daughter of Raymond and Nellie (Muck) Fitch. On May 25, 1935 Ardis was united in marriage to William L. Witt in LaGrange, Indiana. He preceded her in death in 1942.

Ardis graduated from Deerfield High School in 1935 as the class Valedictorian. She went to work for Woodalls in Monroe, Michigan for 17 years and then went to work as a Bank Teller for the Deerfield State Bank in Deerfield for 23 years. Ardis also held the position of Village Treasurer for the Village of Deerfield for 17 years. She was a member of the Deerfield United Methodist Church and in her spare time, enjoyed reading, playing bingo and dominoes and solving word puzzles.

Surviving are her children, John E. (Joan) Witt of Deerfield, Patricia Wright of Petersburg, James (Sandra) Witt of Deerfield and Gaynell (Harley) Sharrock of Deerfield; 8 grandchildren; 20 great-grandchildren and 6 great-great grandchildren. In addition to her husband, William L. Witt, she was preceded in death by her parents, a grandson, Billy Witt, a great-granddaughter, Rachelle Ann Sharrock, 2 brothers, Lawrence and Virgil Fitch and her son-in-law, Victor Wright.
