BLISSFIELD – Audrey M. Brown, 90, of Blissfield passed away on Friday evening, January 22, 2021 at Blissfield Place with her loving family by her side and under the compassionate care of Careline Hospice.

Born May 30, 1930, in Deerfield, she was the daughter of the late Gloyd and Bernice (Cousino) Roe. Audrey was a 1948 graduate of Deerfield High School. She was employed as a bookkeeper until she became a mother. She proudly raised her children and cared for her family and their home. In her spare time, Audrey loved to play Bingo. Audrey was a member of Light of Christ Catholic Parish, St. Peter the Apostle Church in Blissfield. She was also a member of the Catholic Christian Women's Group.
