Blissfield: Beatrice O. Luce, 96, of Blissfield passed away on Friday, October 28, 2011 at the Lenawee Medical Care Facility in Adrian. She was born on January 14, 1915 in Evansport, Ohio, the daughter of Alexander and Flora (Alcock) Birchfield.

Beatrice graduated from Adrian High School in 1934 as the Valedictorian of her class. On June 28, 1937 she was united in marriage to Elwood Luce who preceded her in death in 1973. Beatrice worked for the Blissfield High School cafeteria, retiring in 1978.
