ADRIAN – Calvin L. Scharer, age 93 of Sand Creek, passed away Thursday, February 19, 2015 at Bixby Medical Center.

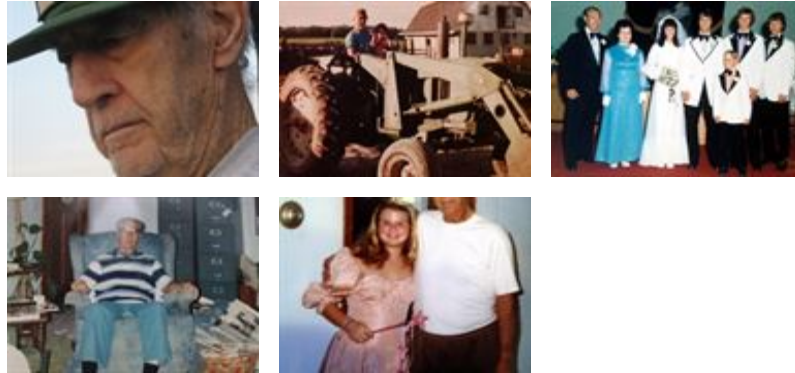
