Monroe, NC-- Carl Herbert Breitkreitz, 85, of Monroe, NC, formerly of Saginaw, MI, Roseville, MI and Ft. Myers, FL passed away on Tuesday, September 23, 2014.

He was born in Fairgrove Township in Michigan on March 12, 1929 to the late August and Valeria Breitkreitz. He received his Master's in Political Science and History from the University of Michigan. He served in the U.S. Army at Ft. Leonard Wood, MO during the Korean Conflict and was honorable discharged in 1954. Carl began his career with the Social Security Administration in 1955 and retired in 1984 as District Manager in Roseville, MI. He was an avid sports fan, especially University of Michigan football and Detroit Red Wings Hockey. Carl was active in Kiwanis, served on the Roseville Library Board, was an elder at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, Roseville, MI and treasurer of Zion Lutheran, Ft. Myers, FL. Following the death of his wife Elizabeth in 2008, Carl moved to the Charlotte area.

He is survived by his children: Patricia Catterfeld, Norma Haakonstad, James Breitkreitz, and Valerie Dine; seven grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren; brother, Edward Breitkreitz; sister, Helen O'Brien and sister-in-law, Margaret Breitkreitz.

Carl was preceded in death by his brothers, Fred and Rudy Breitkreitz and his

sister, Hannah Zelmer.
