ADRIAN- Carl Joseph Meddick, 78, of Adrian, died Friday afternoon, March 17, 2023 at Regency Hospital in Sylvania, Ohio, with his loving family by his side.

Born on July 11, 1944 in Highland Park, Michigan, Carl was the son of John and Grace (Bickel) Meddick. Carl graduated from Cody High School in Detroit and went on to attend Eastern Michigan University.

It was during a church picnic that Carl was introduced to Patricia Shimsky and he knew immediately that she was special. On January 14, 1967 Carl and Patricia were married and they shared many memories and much love in their 56 years together.

Carl believed it was important to be involved in the community you lived in. He was a supervisor for the Department of Social Services, served on the board of Associated Charities and volunteered with Patricia as building supervisors for the Lenawee County Fair. He was a member of the Adrian First United Methodist Church and was active with the AMVETS, Elks and Moose Lodge. He is survived by his loving wife, Patricia; daughter, Heather (Meddick) Reid; granddaughter, Dakotah (Brashia) Reid; and brother, Don (Jennifer) Meddick.
