



Charles "Charlie" Stutzman

February 3, 1921 - December 23, 2010

ADRIAN – Charles O. “Charlie” Stutzman, age 89 years, died suddenly at Herrick Hospital in Tecumseh on December 23, 2010.

Charles was born February 3, 1921, in Ogden Township, the son of Rev. Wilson and Grace (Wotring) Stutzman. He graduated from Metamora High School and attended Michigan State University. During World War II, he served his country for four years in the Army Air Force.

On August 16, 1944, Charles married Irma Setzler in Metamora. Irma, his wife of 66 years, survives.

Charlie was an active life insurance agent for 40 years with Gleaner Life Insurance Society. He was a faithful member of the First Church of the Brethren where he served as Chairman of the Board.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his two children, daughter, Sandra (Bruce) Morrison of Burlington, IA; and son, Lynn (Paulette) Stutzman of Adrian; 3 granddaughters, two step-grandsons, and 11 great grandchildren. He has many nieces and nephews and will be sadly missed by his many relatives and friends.

He was preceded in death by five brothers and three sisters.

The funeral service for Charles will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, December 27, 2010 at Wagley Funeral Home with Rev. David Morton officiating. Burial will follow at Lenawee Hills Memorial Park in Adrian.
