ADRIAN – Clara L. Stevens, 95 of Adrian, passed away Sunday, December 7, 2014, at Lenawee Medical Care Facility.

She was born June 30, 1919, in Ypsilanti, Michigan, the oldest daughter of Warren and Emma (Vorce) Frisbie. After graduating from Addison High School in 1938 she attended Cleveland Bible College.

On September 20, 1947, she married Albert ‘Eldon’ Stevens and they were blessed with 55 years together. He preceded her in death in 2003.

Clara was a member of the Rollin Friends Church and most recently a member of the Adrian First Church of the Nazarene. In addition to teaching Sunday school for 50 years, Clara was active in the WCTU, the Missionary Society, the Addison Women’s Club and Right to Life of Lenawee County. She is survived by two daughters, Loraine (Paul) Stanton of Plymouth and Rachelle Stevens of Adrian; and was a cherished aunt to many nieces and nephews.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by a sister, Laura Masters.
