



Curtis "Curt" Earl Sellick

January 21, 1940 - December 1, 2022

BLISSFIELD- Curtis "Curt" Earl Sellick, 82, of Blissfield, entered eternal life on Thursday evening, December 1, 2022.

Born on January 21, 1940 in Toledo, Ohio, Curtis was the son of Roy and Beulah (Snyder) Sellick. Curt was active in sports while growing up. He graduated from Whitmer High School in 1958 and went on to attend Miami University, in Ohio, on a football scholarship.

He is survived by his high school sweetheart, Kathleen A. Hiltman who he married on August 20, 1960. In addition to his wife, Curtis is survived by their children, Scott (Sherri), Shawn (Frank), Stacey (Joe), Shari (Eduardo), Sara (Andrew) and Shad (Jennifer); 19 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren; and his sister, Gail (Ralph). He was preceded in death by his granddaughter, Taylor; great-granddaughter, Madelynn; son-in-law, Andrew; and brother, Neal.

Curt's competitive nature as an athlete was demonstrated in his work ethic as an adult. His working career began as a carpenter apprentice influenced by his father and grandfather. He took his creative skills to Northern Michigan where he and his brother developed a campground on the scenic shoreline of Lake Michigan. As owner of C.E. Sellick, Inc. in Harbor Springs, MI, he worked in resort development and home construction. Curt and Kathleen returned to their Toledo area roots in 1982 where he finished his career as an estimator/project manager in the large commercial construction industry.

He is remembered by his family as a selfless, dedicated provider; for opening

his door to anyone in need and for sharing his passion for Jesus Christ with anyone he came in contact with. Quality time in the outdoors with those he loved was of utmost importance. In his lifetime, he impacted countless lives and never ceased to pour himself into those who needed a father figure. Curt will be missed by those he loved, but we rejoice with him that he is in the presence of his Savior, Jesus Christ and in the hope that we will join him one day in heaven.
