ADRIAN – David C. Sentle, 72, of Adrian, passed away peacefully, at his home, December 21, 2010.

David was born April 27, 1938, in Adrian, the son of Cecil and Margaret (Heldt) Sentle. He graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1956. From 1956 to 1960, during the Korean Conflict, David served his country in the Navy.

On May 9, 1987, David married Vicki (Willard) Brewer in Adrian. Vicki, his wife for over 23 years, survives.

David was the owner/operator of D & S Auto Parts for many years. He also owned and operated Brooklyn Lanes until his retirement in 2007. David was part of a professional hydroplane race team and also owned and sponsored several cars at the Oak Shade Raceway. An avid golfer, David shared his passion with others at both the Wolf Creek Golf Club and the Woodlawn Golf Club, where he worked and participated in several leagues. He also enjoyed bowling on many leagues. David was raised in St. John's Lutheran Church. He was a member of the Loyal Order of the Moose.

In addition to his wife, David is survived by his children: Lisa Sentle of Arizona; Jeffrey (Catherine) Sentle of Ashland, OR; Marc (Jeanine) Vickery of Lake Orion, MI; and Todd (Kathy) Brewer of Jerome, MI; five grandchildren; and his siblings: Janet (Robert) Pickell of Flushing, MI; Susan (Joe) Hudson of Jonesville, MI; Steve Sentle of Adrian; and Debbie (Joe) Budwit of Addison. He will be missed by his dog, Gidget.
