ADRIAN – David 'Jerry' Wolcott, age 83 died Saturday, February 28, 2015, peacefully in his home surrounded by his loving family.

He was born April 21, 1931 in Flint, MI to Arthur and Lillian (Cheney) Wolcott. On September 10, 1955 he married Beverly Ann Empey. Beverly preceded Jerry in death on February 7, 1985.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Adrian, American Hospital Radiology Association, Michigan Radiology Association, where he was Past President, and American Legion Post 366 out of Flint.
