Blissfield: Dean H. Keller, 81 of Blissfield passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on Wednesday, January 19, 2011 at Lynwood Manor in Adrian, MI. He was born on September 25, 1929 in Deerfield, Michigan, the son of Norman and Margaret (Bierley) Keller. On September 2, 1950, Dean was united in marriage to Marlene Scholl in Angola, Indiana.

Dean graduated from Blissfield High School in 1949 and served in the United States Army during the Korean War conflict.
