Adrian – Dolores (Trevino) Aranda, age 92, of Adrian peacefully completed her life's journey on earth, and entered into eternal life with her Lord on Thursday, March 6, 2014, at Lenawee Medical Care Facility in Adrian. She was surrounded by her loving family. Dolores was born on March 4, 1922 in Melvin, Texas to Simon and Jenoveva (Ruiz) Trevino. Dolores married Porfirio A. Aranda on January 3, 1941, in Brady, Texas, and he preceded her in death on April 5, 1987. Dolores was a lifelong member of St. Mary of Good Counsel Catholic Church and she was a Cursillista. She was also a past member of the Guadalupe Society and the local GI Forum chapter. Dolores was employed at Siena Heights College (University), the Holiday Inn, and at the Piotter Center. She also worked for the Foster Grandparent Program at Garfield School for ten years, under Marcie Brown. She had very fond memories working as a Foster Grandparent, under Tom McNaughton and Sue Gould. In her retirement, she spent many years at home caring for her grandchildren.

Our mom was a pillar of strength and a woman with great pride. She was very proud of her heritage and one who cherished the importance of passing on those roots to her 9 children, 20 grandchildren, and 31 great grandchildren. She enjoyed music, her Spanish television stations, and was also very proud of her children receiving their college educations. But we are most proud of our mother for doing the job that she did in raising all of us, and for the

sacrifices she had made along the way for each of us. We are very thankful and grateful to our Lord who blessed her with 92 years of life. She was the oldest living Aranda. No other Aranda in our history has ever lived to be this age; a sign of her Catholic faith, and her determination throughout her entire life.
