



## Donald 'Bart' Bartholomy

May 20, 1930 - September 2, 2015

ADRIAN—Donald 'Bart' F. Bartholomy, 85 of Adrian, passed away at the Lynwood Manor, Tuesday, September 2, 2015, under the loving care of Hospice of Lenawee.

He was born May 20, 1930, in Oxford, MI to Jules and Arda (Hallock) Bartholomy. Don married Evelyn LeVeque on December 28, 1965, and she preceded him in death January 15, 2007.

Don graduated from Adrian High School in 1948 and later earned a bachelor's degree from Eastern Michigan University. He proudly served his country in the Army during the Korean Conflict. During the 1950's he played football for the Adrian Big Reds, a semi pro football team. Don was a sales executive with Stubnitz-Greene Spring Corp. in Adrian (later known as Hoover Universal, then Johnson Controls) for many years.
