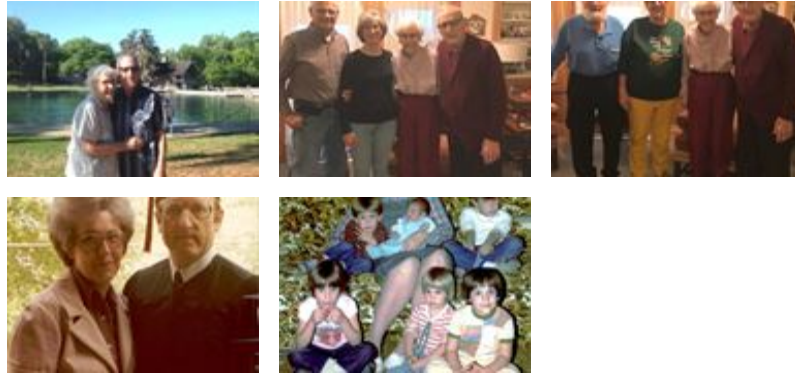
“Dear Bob & family,
