ADRIAN- Douglas "Doug" A. Hasenpflug, 91, of Adrian died on Saturday, January 14, 2023 at Provincial House in Adrian.

He was born on July 11, 1931, at home in Riga, MI the only son of Arnold and Leona (Betz) Hasenpflug. Doug graduated from Blissfield High School in 1949.

On July 28, 1951, Doug married Ann Louise Norden at Trinity Lutheran in Riga and were blessed with 65 years at the time of her death on July 1, 2016.

Doug served his country in the National Guard during the Korean War era. Doug was a true entrepreneur in Lenawee County owning and operating several businesses. For 20 years he brought smiles to many by running the Frosty Boy in Adrian. He operated Doug's Market in Jasper for 10 years and still owned numerous apartments in the Adrian area. Doug often took cars from his collection to local car shows, with his Corvettes and Chargers being some of his favorites. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Riga for many years.

He is survived by his children, Michael (Sandra) Hasenpflug and Barbara Hasenpflug; grandchildren, Kimberly (Paul) Wolf and Parker (Olivia) Hasenpflug and great-grandchildren, Peyton and Preston Mynes, and Gabriela and Reed Hasenpflug.
