May 14, 1939 - December 9, 2020

DEERFIELD— Douglas Lee Scholl, age 81, of Deerfield, died unexpectedly on Thursday, December 9, 2020, at the ProMedica Charles and Virginia Hickman Hospital in Adrian.

Doug was born on May 14, 1939 to Donald and Ione (Lamley) Scholl. He graduated from Deerfield High School with the Class of 1957.

He married Ramona Diver on January 21, 1961 and they have shared 59 years together making wonderful memories and raising a family. Doug worked at Fisher Body before starting Scholl's Slaughter House in 1976, and still worked there until his passing.

Doug and Ramona instilled a strong work ethic in all their children as family meant so much to Doug. He attended all his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren's school activities and sporting events. Doug was always smiling and enjoyed teasing anyone he could; some would say that Doug liked to "stir the pot." He enjoyed golfing and making wine in his free time.
