



## Doyle Hendricks

October 3, 1923 - November 10, 2011

ADRIAN – Dr. Doyle M. Hendricks, 88, of Adrian, passed away Thursday, November 10, 2011, at his home.

He was born October 3, 1923, at Alvordton, Ohio, to Herald and Vera (Douglass) Hendricks. He had a great admiration for his parents' ability to raise five children during the great hardships of 1930 to 1940. In World War II he served with the combat engineers in the Pacific Area.

Doyle graduated from Kunkle High School and the University of Michigan School of Dentistry. He provided dentistry to the City of Adrian from 1951 to his retirement in 1991. He was a member of the Bixby Dental Staff, life member of the Jackson-Adrian and the American Dental Associations. His charitable involvement included Prarie School, The Daily Bread, Meals on Wheels, and volunteer work in Puerto Rico and Katrina Relief in Louisiana. Doyle had a lifetime of involvement in all aspects of the Church of the Brethren. Besides Doyle's church and family, his love of travel took him to all fifty states, Europe, Puerto Rico, and the Caribbean.

He was married in 1951 to his beloved wife, Betty Carr, and to this marriage were born four children: Pam (Ted) Nestell of Saginaw; Dennis (Barbara) Hendricks of Coldwater; Pat (Dick) Bennett and Mark (Kerry) Hendricks, both of Adrian; 11 grandchildren; 7 great grandchildren. Also surviving is a sister,

Catherine Choske; a brother, Merle Hendricks; and a brother-in-law, Clarence Shearer.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, LaMoyle Shearer; a brother, Stanley Hendricks; sisters-in-law, Evelyn and Ina Hendricks, and brother-in-law, George Choske.

The funeral service for Doyle will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, November 14, 2011, at Wagley Funeral Home with Rev. David Morton officiating. Burial will follow at Lenawee Hills Memorial Park in Adrian.
