ADRIAN— Dr. Herbert N. Hood, Sr., DDS, MS age 87 of Adrian, passed away on Thursday, March 5, 2020, at Brookdale Assisted Living.

Herbert was born on August 1, 1932, to Dr. Clifford and Clara (Mitchell) Hood. Upon graduating from Adrian High School, Herbert went on to the University of Michigan where he obtained his Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS, MS) specializing in Orthodontics.
