Duane McGormley died on October 6, 2018. Born to Leona and Harold McGormley on January 22, 1941, he grew up in Fremont, Ohio. After attending Western Reserve University and receiving his bachelor's degree, he married Andrea Wolfe and had two children, Kevin and Denae. He continued his education receiving a MDiv from Evangelical Theological Seminary in Naperville, IL. Later he went back Case Western University for a MFA in theater and drama.

Over the years he served as pastor for EUB and Disciples of Christ churches from Festus, MO to Dothan, AL. He also taught at Lindenwood University near St. Louis where he married his wife Nancy Wohanick. Following the death of Nancy, he lived for three more years in Dothan before moving to Lynwood Manor in Adrian, MI where he died.
