FAYETTE, OH- Edith Helena Clemensen, 87, of Fayette, Ohio died early Friday morning, December 9, 2022 at Fairlawn Haven Nursing Home in Archbold, OH.

Born on December 27, 1934 in Fenton, Michigan, Edith was the daughter of Harold and Vivian (Sanford) Warren. She graduated from Gorham Fayette High School with the Class of 1952 and went on to earn her associates degree from Hillsdale Secretarial School.

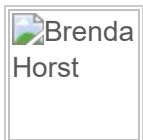
