October 10, 1920 - March 29, 2014

ADRIAN – Ella Mary King, age 93 of Tecumseh, passed away Saturday, March 29, 2014, under the loving care of Hospice of Lenawee.

Born October 10, 1920, in Manitou Beach, Michigan, she was the daughter of Frank and Edna (Bittinger) Pratt. Ella Mary graduated from Addison High School and completed her schooling at Cleary College.
