ADRIAN – Ezdel “Ed” C. Wiser, age 91 of Adrian, passed away Saturday, May 3, 2014, at Promedica Bixby Hospital.

He was born December 10, 1922 in Belpre, Kansas, to Jessie and Molly (Stewart) Wiser.

On May 29, 1948, Ed married Fern Wortman in Owosso, Michigan, and she survives.

Ed served in the United States Army during World War II, handling communications. Upon his return, he went to work for GTE where he retired with 40 years of service. He was a member of the West Adrian Community Church (formerly West Adrian United Church of Christ). Ed was also a long-time member of the YMCA. He had a great love of deer hunting and was an avid bowler. He and Fern delivered Meals on Wheels for several years. They also enjoyed extensive travels visiting 49 of the 50 states.

In addition to Fern, his wife of almost 66 years, he is survived by their children: Dale Wiser of Waldron; Carol (Alan) Robertson of Adrian; Becky (Jerry) Wendling of McMillan, MI; and Terri (Tony) Flippo of Adrian; 11 grandchildren; 15 great grandchildren; and a sister, Ella Skyring of Baton Rouge, LA.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Tom Wiser; and sisters, Louise Peek and Bunny Cline.
