



## Frank Joseph Konath Sr.

Saint Clair Shores – Frank Joseph Konath, Sr., 95 of St. Clair Shores, Michigan died Tuesday afternoon, July 26, 2022 at Otterbein Sunset Village in Sylvania, Ohio.

Born May 26, 1927 in Roseville, Michigan, he was the son of Frank Joseph and Lottie (Kapucinski) Konath. On December 26, 1945, Frank proudly enlisted in the Army and served during World War II. Receiving both the Army of Occupation and the World War II Victory Medals. Making him a member of our Nation's greatest generation. Frank completed high school while serving in the Army.
