ADRIAN – Gary D. Cupp, age 71 of Adrian, passed away Saturday, March 7, 2015, at ProMedica Bixby Hospital.

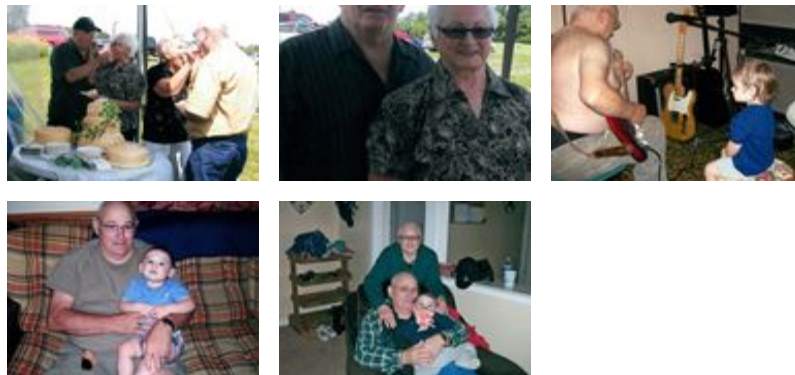
