BLISSFIELD –With deep sadness we share that George Leroy Brown, 74, of Blissfield, passed away after a very brief battle with acute myeloid leukemia (AML).

He was married to his adoring wife Kay for 55 years and was the father of eight children, survived by Lora (Marks), JoNell (Iffland), Nate, Ben, Kayla (Crist), and Kara, and preceded in death by his sons, Andrew and Peter. He leaves behind countless grandchildren, great-grandchildren, international exchange students, and beloved friends.
