ADRIAN- George Theodore Coneset, 81, of Adrian, Michigan died early Monday morning, May 8, 2023 at ProMedica Charles & Virginia Hickman Hospital in Adrian.

George was born on January 14, 1942 in Chicago, Illinois. He was the oldest of three children in George and Elenore Coneset's family. He graduated from Senn High School on the north side of Chicago. After graduation, George joined the United States Marine Corp. where he served his country for four years.

On March 13, 1971 George and Barbara Ausderau were married at Raisin Valley Friends Church in Birdsall, MI. They were blessed with 52 years of love and friendship.

George was a dedicated Adrian City firefighter for 30 years. He earned his associate degree in fire science from Washtenaw Community College. After retiring from the Adrian City fire department, George went to work in Lansing for the Michigan State Police Hazmat Center for 10 years.

George and Barbara were long time members of Christ Redeemer Lutheran Church in Adrian. He enjoyed being outdoors and when he found the time, he would go fishing and deer hunting.

He is survived by his wife, Barbara; sons, James (Amy) Coneset, Theodore (Julie) Coneset and Phong Pham; grandchildren, Hunter and Hannah Coneset; and his brother, Robert (Marge) Coneset. George was preceded in death by his parents, and sister, Christine Coneset.

Following George's wishes, cremation will take place with no services.
