George R. Grau, 71, of Blissfield, went to be with the Lord Monday September 10, 2012 while on his final hunt. He was in Newfoundland on a moose hunt when he lost his 4 ½ year battle with cancer. George was known as a steadfast Christian, family-man and friend.

He was born February 23, 1941, in Cleveland, Ohio, the son of George and Dorothy (Perrine) Grau. After graduating from Brecksville High School, he received a Bachelor's Degree from GMI (Kettering University).

On September 24, 1988, George married Patricia (Steckmyer) Goulart in Adrian. Pat, his wife of 24 years, survives.

George worked for General Motors retiring in 1990 with over 31 years of service. His GM career included assignments at Fisher Body Cleveland, OH, Fisher Body Tecumseh, MI and Inland Fisher Guide Euclid, OH. After retiring, he started his own excavating business, GGI Construction.

After Pat's retirement, she and George spent their winters in Bradenton, Florida where he was a member of the Manatee United Methodist Church. In Blissfield he attended Zion United Brethren Church. He was also a member of the Palmyra Masonic Lodge #184 and the Brecksville Masonic Lodge .

In addition to his wife, George is survived by their children: Janet (Tobias) Bulang of Heidelberg, Germany; Nancy (Mike) DeSantis of Hickory, NC; Dori (Noel) Eisenmann of Blissfield; and Jared (Suzy) Goulart of Lexington, KY; grandchildren: Emma and Noah Bulang, Samantha and Bryce DeSantis, Isaac, Josh, Ricky and Hannah Eisenmann; and Liliya Goulart; and brothers, Tom (Anita) Grau of OH and Bob (Cindy) Grau of NC.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by a grandson, Raphael Bulang, in infancy.

George's family will receive friends at Wagley Funeral Home, Tagsold Chapel in Blissfield on Friday September 28th beginning at 4 pm, concluding at 8 pm with a Masonic service. A Celebration of George's Life will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, September 29, 2012, at Zion United Brethren Church with Rev. Aden Porter officiating. Visitation will also take place at the church from 10 to 11 a.m.
