ADRIAN – Geraldine F. Bailey, 93, of Adrian, passed away Thursday, November 7, 2013, at Lenawee Medical Care Facility.

Born October 29, 1920, in Deerfield, Michigan, she was the oldest child of Russell and Barbara (Kirsch) Macham. She graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1939.

On July 3, 1942, Geraldine married Everett Bailey on the Board Walk in Atlantic City, and they celebrated 50 years of marriage.

Geraldine retired from Adrian College where she had worked in the dining hall for many years as a baker. She was known and loved by many as the “Cookie Lady”.
