ADRIAN – Geraldine (Gerry) L. Bartlett, age 88, of Adrian, passed away Thursday, April 29, 2010 at Provincial House.

Geraldine was born June 13, 1921 in Adrian, the only daughter of Leon G. and Velma O. (Denniston) Covell. She graduated in 1940 from Adrian High School in the top 20 of her class. On August 4, 1945, Geraldine married Donald Bartlett at the First United Methodist Church in Adrian. Donald and Geraldine celebrated over 49 years of marriage prior to his death in 1995.

Gerry was involved with the Adrian High School Alumni, and helped organize reunions and luncheons for the Class of 1940.

Gerry is survived by her son, Gary Bartlett and his wife Esther; a daughter, Patricia Smith and her husband, Charles, all of Adrian; and a granddaughter, Nora Bartlett of Chicago. She is also survived by five step grandchildren and seven step great grandchildren.

In addition to her husband, Gerry was preceded in death by two brothers, Dorman and Duane Covell.
