ONSTED – The Lord called Glendora M. Mason to her eternal home Wednesday, October 5, 2011.

She was born January 23, 1916, at home in North Adrian, Michigan, the daughter of Harry and Dora (Steele) Fox.

On June 12, 1934, she married Wilbur Mason in Wellsville, Michigan. Glendora and Wilbur celebrated 36 years of marriage prior to his death in 1971.

Glendora was a charter member of the Union Gospel Church and remained devoted to her Lord throughout her life. With a strong work ethic, Glendora worked on the family farm, served as a 4-H leader, was a seamstress, and made numerous quilts. She was well known for wonderful pies.
