ADRIAN – Gordon L. ‘Gordy’ Giroux, 66, of Adrian passed away, Monday, November 8, 2010.

Gordon was born July 5, 1944 to Leo and Lillian (Grinnell) Giroux. He attended Onsted Schools and enlisted in the army after graduating.
