ADRIAN - Graham A. Teague, age 74 of Adrian, passed away Tuesday, May 9, 2017.

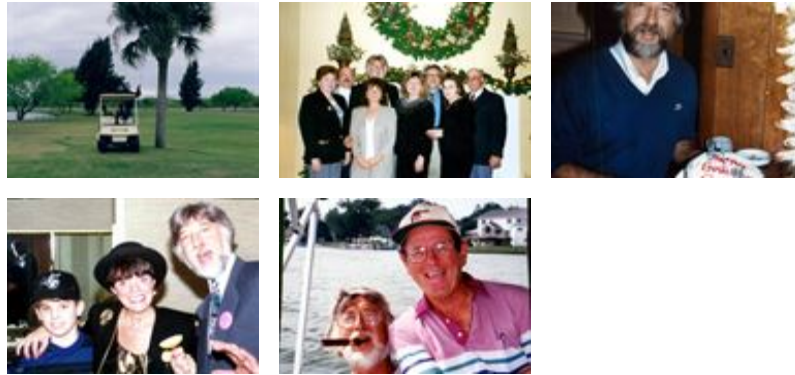
