ADRIAN—Gregory ‘Greg’ L. Warfield, age 69 of Adrian, passed away Monday, March 20, 2017, at home under the loving care of his family assisted by Hospice of Lenawee.

Greg was the only child of Rex H. and Barbara (Palko) Warfield born on October 24, 1947 in San Francisco, CA. He was raised by his grandparents, Belle and Edwin Warfield. On September 5, 1971, he married Mary Ellen Matteson in Jackson, MI, she survives.

After graduating from Jackson High in 1966, he then attended JCC where he earned his Associates degree, later he attended U of M and earned a Bachelor’s degree in Journalism and a Master’s degree from Michigan State.
