ADRIAN – Harold F. Brehmer, 94, of Adrian, passed away August 31, 2011, at Bixby Medical Center.

He was born March 28, 1917, in Adrian, the only son of Thomas and Minnie (Prelipp) Brehmer. Harold graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1934. During World War II, he honorably served our country in the United States Air Force and was the recipient of the Purple Heart Medal.

On April 12, 1947, Harold was married to Esther Muck. They celebrated over 63 years of marriage prior to her death in January of this year.

Harold worked for Brazeway in purchasing for many years, retiring in 1983.

He was a faithful member of St. John's Lutheran Church where he served as a Trustee. He was also a member of the Bixby Auxiliary, serving as a volunteer; and the Lenawee Country Club where he enjoyed playing golf.

Harold is survived by his daughter, Barbara (Charles) Leutwiler of Skokie, Illinois; grandsons, Trey (Geanine) also of Skokie, and Andrew (Flor) and their daughters, Kady and Kate of Las Cruces, New Mexico; and a number of nieces and nephews.

In addition to his wife, he was preceded in death by two sisters, Mildred Peck and Nelda "Pat" Curtiss.
