



Harold L. "Pix" Pixley

December 11, 1935 - April 29, 2016

PALMYRA – Harold L. "Pix" Pixley, age 80 of Palmyra, passed away Friday, April 29, 2016 at Toledo Hospital, surrounded by his treasured family.

He was born December 11, 1935, in Britton, Michigan, the only son of Frank and Grace (Whipple) Pixley. He graduated from Blissfield High School with the Class of 1953.

On July 17, 1954, he was married to Nina Carpenter at St. Alphonsus Church in Deerfield, and they have celebrated over 61 years together.

Pix was a lifelong farmer. He was also a tool and die maker who worked with several businesses before starting P & R Tool which later became Tech Machine Tool in Tecumseh. Pix was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Adrian. He was a charter member of Knights of Columbus Council #7832 in Blissfield as well as a member of a local genealogy group. Pix enjoyed playing horse shoes and was president of the Buttonwood Bay Horse Shoe Club in Florida for four years.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by their three sons: David (Kathy) of Palmyra, Steven (Cheryl) of Tecumseh, and Kenneth (Angie) of Byhalia, MS; seven grandchildren: Rebecca (David) Brewer, David (Tammy) Pixley, Laura (Chad) Fisher, Jennifer (James) Forgacs, Michael (Elizabeth) Pixley, Melissa and Jacob Pixley; and eight great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Bonnie, in infancy; a son, Donald; and a granddaughter, Amanda.
