DEERFIELD – Harry L. Woodbury, Sr., 84, of Deerfield, died early Sunday morning, October 14, 2012, at his home in his sleep. Harry is now resting from a hard journey with Alzheimer's.

Harry was born in Carbon, Iowa on May 11, 1928 to John H. and Mary S. (Walton) Woodbury Sr.

He was a veteran of the Korean War serving in both the Navy and the Marine Corps.
