She was born 1914 to Rev. Pearl and William Powers. She was married to Gerald Jenkins in 1932. To this union four children were born, Devon, Colleen, Darlene and Darryl.

Hazel started teaching at age 16 in United Brethren Church, teaching many age groups, was Junior Superintendent for 10 years, conducted several Bible schools, past president of Hope W.M.A., past president of W.M.A. Council. Hazel sang in the choir for many years. Hazel and Gerald started the Upstreamers class. She was past president of the local PTA, also past council president of the City of Adrian and Lenawee County PTA. She sang with Mother Singers for years. In 1952, Hazel was selected by Chamber of Commerce as Mother of the Year for church, schools and community work. She was known as “Aunt Hazel” after the death of her husband in 1981. She was married to Arthur Jabaay in 1984. She spent many winters in Sunny Shores, Cortez, Florida. Hazel traveled a lot in her golden years. In Florida, she was past president of Federation of Garden Clubs of Sunny Shores, member of Couples Class of West Bradenton Baptist Church, member of Busy Bees Club in Park, and assistant teacher of Bible Study in Park. She was preceded in death by her parents; two brothers Elmer and William Powers; two sisters Alice Kapnick and Pearl Staup; sister in law, Betty Campbell, daughter-in-law Janet Jenkins, and granddaughter Jackie Ball.
