BLISSFIELD – Helen A. Powell, age 94 of Blissfield, passed away Tuesday, January 9, 2018, after a lengthy illness.

She was born May 12, 1923, in Adrian, Michigan to Earl and Edna (Bigelow) Wilson, and graduated from Blissfield High School in 1941.

On June 11, 1946, she married Donald Powell, in Bowling Green, Ohio, and they have celebrated over 71 years together.

Helen and Don were charter members of Ogden Community Bible Church where she was active in the children's ministries. In recent years, they have attended Jasper Bible Church, Blissfield Baptist Church and Cornerstone Baptist Church. Helen was also involved with the Michigan State University Extension Service. For several years they lived in LaGrange, Texas and continued to enjoy winters there after retiring and returning to Michigan. While living in Texas, Helen and Don volunteered with Texas Baptist Builders, assisting in the construction of 19 churches.
