ADRIAN – Ilah May Yeutter, 90, of Adrian, passed away Friday, April 8, 2011, at her home.

Ilah May was born May 18, 1920, in Onsted, Michigan, the only daughter of Earl and Minnie (Mapes) Kimball. She graduated from Onsted High School.

On June 2, 1940, Ilah May married Glenn Yeutter. They celebrated 55 years of marriage prior to his death in 1996.

She was well-known as the owner and operator, along with her husband, Glenn, of Yeutter Dairy Freezer. She was a member of the Rome Grange for over 75 years.
