



Irma V Overmyer

March 3, 1919 - September 24, 2012

Sylvania—Irma V. Overmyer, age 93, formerly of Deerfield, passed away Monday, September 24, 2012 at Flower Hospital, with her loving son, Robert Jr. by her side.

Irma, the youngest of seven children, was born March 3, 1919 to Anna (Stepp) and Joseph Lavengood in Elsie, Michigan. On October 18, 1947, Irma married Robert Overmyer Sr. in Angola, IN. He preceded her in death on February 2, 1975.

She graduated from Monterey High School in Winamac, IN with the class of 1937. Irma attended Lansing Business School. She worked as a secretary in the Veteran's Administrative Office in New Orleans during WW II, then later at Revco in Deerfield. She retired from Deerfield Public Schools, where she worked in the office. Not one to stay inactive, she returned to work at Bixby Hospital where she worked in medical records, retiring in 1984.

Irma was a former member of United Methodist Church in Deerfield. She volunteered at the Franciscan Center, Lourdes College in Sylvania and also at WTVG television station with the "Call for Action", helping people solve their problems with the area businesses.

Survivors include, her sons, Robert Jr. of Sylvania, OH and Mark Overmyer of Kansas City, MO.

In addition to her husband, Irma was preceded in death by her parents and her sisters and brothers.

Irma will be at 1: 00 p.m. on Friday, September 28, 2012 at Deerfield Cemetery with Pastor Michael Clemmer officiating.
